Not only did He warn that those who were not "Born Again" would never enter eternal Heaven, He warned of the reality of eternal Hell which is the only alternative to Heaven.

John 3:3

Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
